Because of the hard work and dedication of our team, partners, and the Goodwill Board of Directors, I am proud of the impact our organization continues to make through our mission for people and our communities.



Over 5.5 million pounds of material was kept out of local landfills, creating jobs and putting valuable material in the hands of those who desperately need it in developing nations of the world. Goodwill's retail and recycling efforts have a positive economic impact right here in Northeast Iowa and throughout the world. When you donate or shop at your local Goodwill, you not only help people in your community - you also help protect the planet.

MISSION SERVICES

From classroom learning to on-the-job experiences, Goodwill programs help people realize their potential — while earning wages during these learning opportunities. Residential support services are designed to help people with disabilities live in their own home or with up to three roommates. Direct service workers provide instruction and support in everything from budgeting to housekeeping for more than **250 people in northeast lowa**.

OUR MISSION:

To help People Overcome Barriers to Independence

Goodwill is a CARF accredited provider of rehab services and our Direct Support Professionals are certified with training in CPR, First Aid, Dependent Adult/Child Abuse Reporting, HIPPA and Certified Residential Medication Management. This service is provided on an hourly or daily basis and can cover 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

LITERACY PROGRAM

A child's reading skills are important to their success in school and opens doors to all kinds of new worlds for them. Goodwill's partnership with community organizations, allows us to provide quality childrens books for the Cedar Valley Readers,' Little Free Libraries, Booking Brighter Futures, Reach Out & Read programs and much more. Goodwill also provides cookbooks to the Northeast Iowa Food Bank that are distributed along with pantry items to the food insecure of our community.
