

Goodwill is a CARF accredited provider of rehab services and our Direct Support Professionals are certified with training in CPR, First Aid, Dependent Adult/Child Abuse Reporting, HIPPA and Certified Residential Medication Management. This service is provided on an hourly or daily basis and can cover 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.



### LITERACY PROGRAM

A child's reading skills are important to their success in school and opens doors to all kinds of new worlds for them. Goodwill's partnership with community organizations, allows us to provide quality childrens books for the Cedar Valley Readers,' Little Free Libraries, Booking Brighter Futures, Reach Out & Read programs and much more. Goodwill also provides cookbooks to the Northeast Iowa Food Bank that are distributed along with pantry items to the food insecure of our community.
